



## **Clean Air Zones, Low Emission Zones, Ultra Low Emission Zones and Zero Emission Zones across the UK**

Air pollution is a growing concern for the public health in the UK, with toxic emissions having negative effects on health and the environment. In response, many cities in the UK are taking measures to help reduce pollution levels and improve air quality.

- Clean Air Zone (CAZ) is being introduced to restrict the most polluting vehicles from entering certain areas of a city, incentivising people to switch to cleaner alternatives.
- Low Emission Zone (LEZ) is an area where only certain vehicles are allowed to enter based on their emissions standards.
- Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ) is an area in central London where vehicles which don't meet the ULEZ emission standards are required to pay a daily charge to drive within the zone.
- Zero Emission Zone (ZEZ) is an area where polluting vehicles are prohibited from entering or permitted to enter upon payment of a daily charge.
